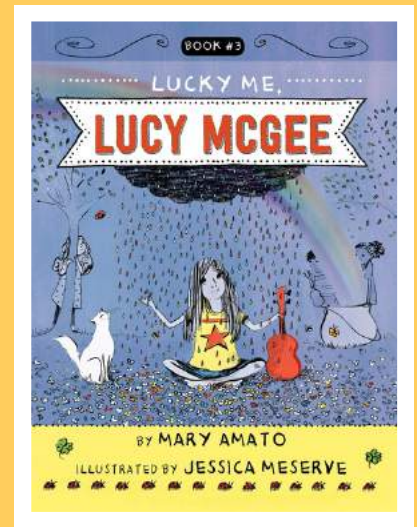


## Virtual Book Banter
