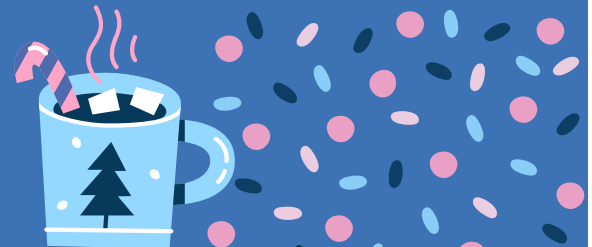

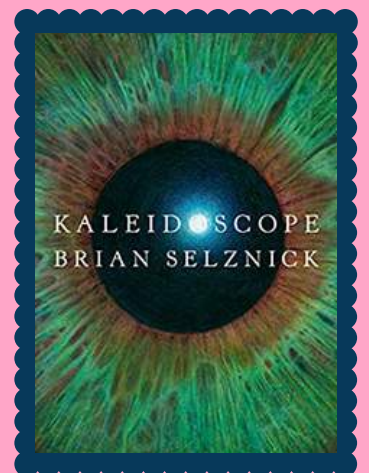
## Virtual Book Banter

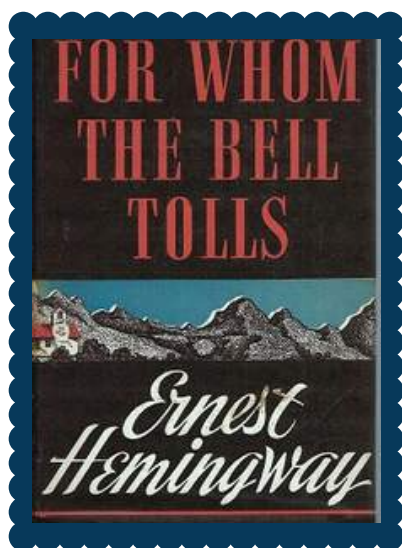
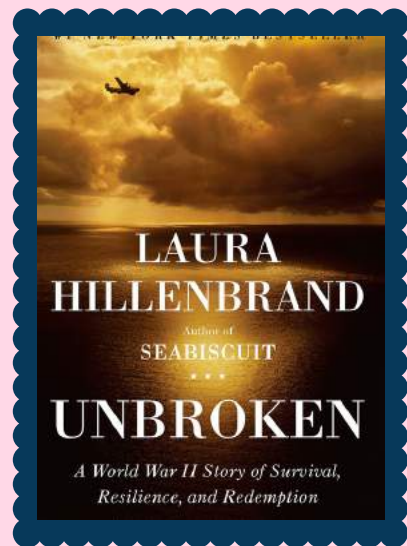
